Sinopharm, Sinovac, Covaxin** (authorized by WHO)	2 doses + 1 dose of mRNA vaccine*	7 days after the third dose
Autres vaccins (not recognized by either the EMA or the WHO)	no	These vaccines are not authorized to enter New Caledonia
