

## COMPELLING REASONS

<b>COMPELLING FAMILY REASONS</b>	
<b>Cause</b>	<b>Justification</b>
Death of a close relative (father, mother, brother, sister, child, spouse).	Death certificate + family record book establishing the family connection.
Assistance to a vulnerable relative (father, mother, brother, sister, child, spouse)	Medical certificate establishing the vulnerable situation and the need for assistance to the person + family record book establishing the family connection.
Visit to a relative whose prognosis is vital (father, mother, brother, sister, child, spouse).	Medical certificate establishing the situation of the person whose prognosis is vital + family record book establishing the family connection
Exercise of a right of custody recognized by a court decision.	Copy of the court decision + proof of address.
Returning home.	Two proofs of address (including a tax certificate establishing the main place of residence).
Summons by an administrative or judicial authority;	Convocation by the administrative or judicial authority.

<b>COMPELLING HEALTH REASON</b>	
<b>Cause</b>	<b>Justification</b>
Medical emergency.	Medical certificate from the doctor or hospital in New Caledonia.

<b>COMPELLING PROFESSIONAL REASON</b>	
<b>Cause</b>	<b>Justification</b>
Mission essential to the continuation of an economic activity requiring a presence on site that cannot be postponed.	Certificate from the employer.
End of a one-time professional assignment.	Proof of completion of the mission + proof of address.
Relocation for professional reasons.	Proof of employment or transfer by the employer (with a contract of more than 6 months) + proof of residence.
Examinations or competitive exams	Invitation to the competition or examination.
One-time mission linked to the exercise of public authority that cannot be deferred or postponed.	Professional card or mission order.
